

The annual Hoop for Coop events serve as a poignant tribute to the enduring legacy of Kimyatta D. Cooper, a revered leader in the Akron community whose life was tragically cut short. Kimyatta D. Cooper's impact on the community was profound, and the events are specifically designed to commemorate his memory while raising awareness about heart health.

The genesis of the Hoop for Coop events is rooted in the untimely passing of Kimyatta D. Cooper, who, at the age of 34, suffered a massive heart attack while engaged in a game of basketball. His sudden and unexpected demise left an indelible void in the hearts of those who knew him and admired his contributions to the community.


In order to honor Kimyatta's commitment to community leadership and to draw attention to the importance of heart health, the Hoop for Coop events have become an annual tradition. Since its inception, GGCP's annual Hoop for Coop events have provided attendees with preventive health screenings such as blood pressure and vision checks, physicals, medical advice, and health related information.




